## **General Regulations**

The International Arabian Horse Show "A" is organized by the *Association du Salon du Cheval* (ASC), under the aegis of the ECAHO and in collaboration with the *Association Royale Morocaine des Eleveurs des Chevaux Pur Sang Arabe* (ARMECPSA) and the *Societé Royale Encouragement du Cheval* (SOREC). It is organized under the current ECAHO/EAHSC regulation.

#### **C – GENERAL CONDITIONS**

#### C1. Admission and qualification of horses

The show is open to any Arabian horse registered in recognized studbook on the date of registration and having obtained one of the following qualifications in 2022, 2021, 2020 or 2019:

- 1<sup>st</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> in Shows "A" or "B"
- 1<sup>st</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> at the national championship
- 1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> at C National, C International and European Show
- 1<sup>st</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> in the yearling classes of a *Tille* or A show
- 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place at Specific Origin Shows.
- For one-year-old fillies and colts, no qualification is required.

NB: the 2019 horse qualifications will only be considered if there are insufficient numbers of qualified horses in 2020, 2021 and 2022.

A quota per country may be set. Horse entries will be open from Monday, August, 15<sup>th</sup> to Friday, September 16<sup>th</sup>, 2022 and a selection committee will decide definitively on the entered horses.

Entries must be made either online via the link ( <u>www.eljadidashow.com</u>) or by e- mail at <u>secretary@eljadidashow.com</u>.

The entry form must be signed and attached to the copy of the horse's passport, respecting the schedule below:

- Closing of preliminary entries:

Friday, September 16th, 2022

- Entries confirmation to participants:

Thursday, September 24th, 2022

#### **C2.** Special conditions

- \* Competitors from all countries (except Spain and Portugal): The owner of each horse selected to participate in the "A" Show of El Jadida 2022, will receive an allowance set at 2,500 euros per horse (two thousand five hundred euros), as a contribution to the cost related to the transport and the stay of the registered horse.
- \* Competitors from Spain and Portugal: The owner of each horse selected to participate in the International Show of El Jadida 2022, coming from Spain or Portugal, will receive an allowance set at 2,000 euros per horse (two thousand euros), as a contribution to the costs related to the transport and the stay of the registered horses.

The allowances will be paid by bank transfer to the owners of the participating horses or their duly authorized representatives (handwritten certificate signed by the principal), and this immediately after confirmation by the competent authorities of Morocco of the re-export of these horses. The organizers of the "A" Show will not pay any additional fees or expenses incurred by participants.

#### C3. Commitments

Horse entries are free. The entry file consists of the following documents:

- The entry form, one copy per horse, on which is indicated the name of the handler in capital letters and must be signed by the owner of the horse or another authorized person;
- A copy of the horse's identification booklet or passport;
- The equine influenza vaccination certificate;
- A copy of the handler's passport or national identity card.

Failing this, the organizers will not accept the entry. No change of ownership can be considered by the organizers after the closing date for entries.

## C4. Responsibility

The organizers of Show "A" decline any liability for any accidents, material damage, illness or damage caused for and by a third party on the competition grounds and within the confines of the Show. Signing the entry form engages the owner's civil and criminal liability.

#### C5. Qualifying classes

Class 1: 1 year old fillies born in 2021	Class 6: 1 year old colts born in 2021
Class 2: 2 years old fillies born in 2020	Class 7: 2 years old colts born in 2020
Class 3: 3 years old fillies born in 2019	Class 8: 3 years old colts born in 2019
Class 4: Females 4 to 6 years old	Class 9: Males 4 to 6 years old
Class 5: Females aged 7 years and over	Class 10: Males aged 7 years and over.

The classification could be modified depending on the number and category of entries.

### C6. Scoring during qualifying classes

Horses will be judged individually at the halt, walk and trot. Each judge will assign scores for type, head and neckline, body, legs and movements. The scoring system, out of 20 with ½ points will be adopted.

#### C7. "Open" Championship Rules

The top three horses in each category will be qualified to compete in their respective championship provided that there are at least five participants in the class. Otherwise, only the first two of the class will be qualified to participate in their championship.

The Gold, Silver or Bronze Champions may be selected by the judges from among any of the qualified horses of each category participating in the championships. Judging at the championships will be done in a comparative way by the entire jury of the Show:

- Rules for Yearlings, Juniors and Seniors Championships:
  - o A horse cited for the Gold medal by a judge obtains 4 points;
  - o A horse cited for the Silver medal by a judge obtains 2 points;
  - o A horse quoted for the Bronze medal by a judge obtains 1 point;
  - o The Gold Medal will be awarded to the horse that obtains the most votes from the judges;
  - The silver medal will be awarded to the horse that has obtained the greatest number of points after the 1st.
  - The Bronze medal will be awarded to the horse that has obtained the greatest number of points after the 2nd.

#### C8. Rule in the event of a tie

- Rules in the event of a tie in the qualifying classes

The best place is given to the horse that has the highest points for the type. If there is still a tie, the highest place is awarded to the horse with the highest gait score. If the ties cannot yet be decided, If a tie cannot yet be decided, one of the judges drawn must indicate his preference.

#### - Rules in the event of a tie in the Championships

The best place is given to the horse with the best score in the class. If there is still a tie, the same rule as for the qualifying classes will be applied.

All gold champions will be subject to a urine and/or blood sample for doping control according to the FEI regulations in force. However, the DC, if it deems it useful, may have any other horse engaged in the competition removed for an anti-doping check.

#### C9. Handlers

Handlers must be over the age of 18, dressed in suitable attire, without any markings or distinctive features, and must be in possession of an ECAHO license in good standing.

The DC will scrupulously ensure compliance with the rules of ECHAO competitions in force (RCS), in particular, everything related to animal welfare (prohibition of plastic bags, etc.).

#### C10. Veterinary visit

All horses are subject to a veterinary visit before admission to the Show stables from Sunday October 16<sup>th</sup> to Tuesday, October 18<sup>th</sup>, 2022.

Feeding the horses is in the charge of the owner. However, hay, straw, wood chips, as well as barley, oats and complete feed will be for sale on the site.

## C11. Horse number

The horse number will be given to the handlers after the veterinary and the disciplinary committee control on **Tuesday, October 18<sup>th</sup>, 2022** from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. The horses will be accompanied by their identification and health documents.

#### **D – SPECIFIC CONDITIONS**

#### D1. Arrival and departure of horses

Horses must arrive no later than Monday, October 17<sup>th</sup>, 2022 before 4 p.m. and must leave on Friday, October 21<sup>st</sup>, 2022 from 10 AM.

#### D2. Feeding

Feeding the horses is the responsibility of the owner. However, hay, straw, wood chips, as well as barley, oats and complete feed will be for sale on the site.

#### D3. Barns

A boxing area with litter will be reserved for the accommodation of horses on their arrival. A day and night security service will be provided, it is recommended that each person entitled to access the stables area have his access badge.

#### D4. Veterinary care, farriery

Emergency veterinary care on the site of *Salon du cheval* will be provided by the ASC. Furriery services are the exclusive responsibility of the participants.

E – EQUIPMENT

#### E1. Qualifying classes:

- Winners: gifts, award plaques and rosettes;

- 2<sup>nd</sup> place: award plaques and rosettes;

- 3<sup>rd</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> place: rosettes

#### E2. Championships:

- Special Trophies.
- Art object.
- Award plates and rosettes.

F – DIVERS

#### F1. Claims

Any complaint must be written and filed with the Disciplinary Committee, at the latest one hour after the facts and must be accompanied by an amount equivalent to 200 Euros in cash.

#### F2. Insurance

All participants must have their personal insurance valid. Horses and equipment remain under the care and responsibility of the participants for the duration of their attendance at the Salon du Cheval d'El Jadida.

#### F3. Customs' formalities,

Each participant must take care, personally, of the transport of his horses and the expenses inherent in the administrative costs.

**G-ACCOMMODATIONS** 

The participants in "A" Show, must provide themselves with their own conditions of stay, hotel reservation, meals and special transfers. A shuttle between Casablanca's Mohammed V International Airport and El Jadida could be set up. In order to benefit from this, participants are advised to send the organizers the number of people, the origin, the arrival times and the flight numbers.
