

BLUE BOOK 2022 CORRECTIONS SHEET

1) Using class results as Championship results

Rules for Affiliation, Championship titles, page 5

If a category is represented by only one class, the ranking in that class may be used as a Championship ranking for that category.

2) Number of qualified horses for Championship

Rules for Affiliation, Championship titles, page 5

If a category is represented by more than one class, these are considered qualifying classes for the respective championship of that category. If the top 5 system is not used, then at the discretion of the organizer, the top 2 or the top 3 of each class qualifies for the championship. This choice may vary per category but it must be stated clearly in the schedule and the catalogue.

3) List of horses entered to A and Title shows must be sent to ECAHO Office for qualification check latest 7 days before the start of the show

Rules of Affiliation, rules for affiliation of A and Title shows, pages 6, 7, 8, 10, 11, 12, 13

A list of horses entered in the show must be sent to the Executive Secretary **immediately** after the closing date of entries, but no later than 7 days before the start of the Show, to check the qualifications of the horses.

4) Judging criterium “Body & Topline” changed to “Body”

Rules of Affiliation, rules for affiliation of all shows, pages 6 - 24

Each judge gives 1-20 points for the following criteria:

- a) type, b) head & neck, c) body, d) legs, e) movement.

5) National anthems at the European Championship – the national anthem of the Owner to be played

Rules for Affiliation, rules of affiliation of the European Championship, page 8

National Anthems: In the case of the champions, the Owners National Anthem should be played.

6) Judges list for all C International, European and Specific Origin shows must contain at least one Judge invited from EAHSC A or B list of Judges

Rules for Affiliation, rules of affiliation of C International, European and Specific Origin shows, pages 17, 18, 21

Judges: At least one judge must be chosen from the EAHSC A and B list of judges. Those judges chosen from non-ECAHO Member country must be selected from the judges' panel of a national Arab Horse Organisation. Any judge who is not on the EAHSC list of judges must produce a signed and validated Contract for judges not listed on ECAHO EAHSC A or B list of judges.

7) Approved Show schedule to be published on ECAHO website (for better access by the DCs and to avoid any possible deviations from the approved version)

Rules for Affiliation, art. 5, page 25

5. The approved show schedule shall be published with the public announcement that a show is being organised. Once it has been published, the approved schedule will be posted on the ECAHO website. After its publication, it may not be changed by the show organiser without prior notice to the exhibitors and to EAHSC.

8) Electronic catalogue may not be published until the start of the respective class

Roles for Conduct of Shows, art. 6, pages 28-29

6. a) No announcement indicating the identity, breeding or past performance of exhibits, or the identity of their owners will be made during judging. It is, however, permissible for this information to be given out after the judges score sheets have been collected for each exhibit.

b) Show organisers will not release details of competitors or their exhibits to the press at any time prior to the catalogue being put on sale at the showground. Catalogues will not be offered for sale more than one day before the commencement of the show. Digital publishing, sharing or posting on internet or any other public media of details regarding participating horses in a show in catalogue format, is not allowed until the start of the respective class.

9) Procedure in the Collecting ring – Handlers, assistants, no unnecessary chasing the horse

Rule for Conduct of Shows, art. 23c), page 32

23. c) Procedure in the Collecting ring

No more than 2 persons are allowed to assist the handler in the collecting ring. These persons as well as the handler should wear the number of the horse, to identify them clearly. Anybody not wearing a number relevant to a horse in the respective class will not have access to the collecting ring. The show organizer must provide three sets of numbers per horse to all exhibitors.

Only one person is permitted to assist the handler during the warm-up, using only a standard schooling whip with an attachment of plastic of max. 10 cm.

All other support or aggravation from inside or outside the collecting ring is prohibited.

Horses may be warmed up in the collecting ring, but to avoid injuries and overstressing the horses, they may only be lunged in big circles at a modest pace. Any chasing, hunting, or scaring of the horse is forbidden.

10) During prize giving ceremony horse may be only led by the designated handler/person

Rules for Conduct of Shows, art. 26, page 32 + Rules for Championships, pages 36, 38, 39, 41

During the prizegiving ceremony, the horse may only be on the lead of the designated handler or substitute deemed capable at the discretion of the ringmaster/DC.

2. To have acted at a minimum of fifteen shows during these five years, at least five of which as Chairman of the DC at International shows.

13) Rules for selection of Judges for A and Title shows (applied by the Executive Committee)

VII. ADDENDUM, Procedure of Affiliation priorities of ECAHO Shows, page 63

Rules for selection of Judges for A and Title shows

- No more than 1 judge from each country shall be selected.
- No more than 2 judges who are currently members of the Executive Committee shall be selected.
- If the judge, due to conflict of interest, is not able to judge more than 50 % of the classes, this judge must be replaced by a different judge from the approved list of judges.

Show Organizers must not invite Judges until the list of judges has been approved by the Executive Committee.
