Class 24 Pure Novice (Arab/Anglo/PBA). Judge: Mr k Lee Pure Novice horses will not be ridden by the judge, horses aged 4yrs and over must wear any suitable bridle. Exhibits MUST NOT have previously entered an open HOYS class at an AHS affiliated show. Horses not to have won a first prize before 1st January in the current year at any AHS affiliated show. Being placed first in a Pure Novice class does not change the Novice status of a horse under the AHS Rules for Showing.

This Show is affiliated to the Arab Horse Society and to the European Conference of Arab Horse Organisations (ECAHO). The rules of both organisations apply to classes 1 to 14 ECAHO Rules taking precedence where there could be a clash or conflict. Classes 15 onwards fall outside the jurisdiction of ECAHO and only the AHS Rules apply to them. The ECAHO Disciplinary Committee is responsible for enforcing the ECAHO rules.

EQUINE FLU VACCINATIONS

SIMON CONSTABLE EQUINE VETS and BINLEY ARABIAN STUD CAROLINE SUSSEX Ridden Purebred Arab of the Year (Horse of the Year Show Qualifier)

Judges: Mrs N Mellor (ride) and Mrs M Gaddas-Brown (conformation)

Classes 33, 34 and 35 - The Classic Show has been granted Horse of the Year Show qualifying status. This competition is for Ridden Purebred Arabians. Owners of qualified horses must be members of the Arab Horse Society and the horse registered in their owner's name. The exhibitor must have purchased an AHS Q card displaying the name of the horse. This class will be run in accordance with the general rules as set out in the Horse of the Year rulebook. Rules can be downloaded from here: https://hoys.co.uk/wp-content/uploads/2022/03/HOYS-Rules-2022.pdf (General rules but specific breed ones too p37)

The qualifying horse will be the highest placed, previously unqualified, exhibit within the Championship of the mare, stallion and gelding sections. If a rider has qualified more than one horse, that rider will be allowed to exchange horses and ride each horse for its individual display. A groom is allowed into the ring to hold the horse whilst it is not being ridden. At the final: Qualifiers should be marked in the following way: Ride 50 maximum Conformation 50 maximum In the case of equality, the horse with the highest Conformation mark will be deemed the winner. If there still be equality at this point, then the judges' decision will be final.

This class is a qualifying class for Horse of the Year Show, NEC, Birmingham, 5th - 9th October 2022. Qualification will not pass below 6th place. Qualification will be verified by the Horse of the Year Show office.

This is a Horse of the Year Show qualifier. All data given upon entry of this class (33, 34 and 35) is provided to Grandstand Media Ltd and stored on the Grandstand entries system. For full policy details, please visit: www.grandstandentries.com.

AHS Q Cards cost £30 per horse per season and must be purchased at least one week before the date of the class in which the horse will compete. Proceeds will be used for sponsorship at Horse of the Year Show. AHS Q Cards are available from **The Arab Horse Society**, Agriculture House, Charnham Lane, Hungerford, Berkshire RG17 OEY. Please make cheques payable to 'Arab Horse Society'. Telephone: 01672 520782.

Results will be checked and any horse found not to have been issued with an AHS Q Card within the specified time will be deemed not to have qualified. Qualification will then pass down to the next unqualified horse in the top 4, who has paid. There will be no opportunity to pay the fee retrospectively.

All riders in Horse of the Year Show qualifying classes at this show must be members of the AHS before entering the ring. Random checks will be made by the AHS and any rider found not to have paid their membership before commencement of the class will be disqualified from taking part. Any awards won by an exhibitor later found to be ridden by a non-member will pass down to the next eligible exhibit and the result will be publicised. There will be no opportunity to pay the fee retrospectively. The show entry fee is £25 plus a supplement of £16 Horse of the Year Show contribution.





The Classic Show Rules 2022

This show is run under AHS and ECAHO Rules which take precedent.

- 1. Conditions of Entry: All Arabian/Anglo/PBA exhibits must be registered in their respective Stud Books. Part Bred Arab horses or ponies must have a minimum of 12.5% of Arab blood. Anglo Arabs carry the blood of Arab and Thoroughbred only and in any proportion
- 2. Entries: Must be made using https://www.myridinglife.com/eventdetails.aspx?id=382962 completing the information as requested. Correct Entry Fees must be paid at the time of entry. AHS documents and HOYS form MUST be emailed to theclassicshow@outlook.com Your entry will not be accepted until such documents are received. Any number of entries may be made upon the payment of the appropriate fee in accordance with the schedule for each class. The Committee may at their discretion refuse to accept any entry, the entry together with the fee will be returned and no correspondence will be entered into with regard to the non-acceptance. There will be no refunds on entry fees. Only the nominated animal may enter the ring for judging. It is sometimes unavoidable that competitors may find that their classes clash, if this should occur then it is up to the individual competitor to choose which class they compete in.
- 3. Correctness of Entry: Every exhibitor is responsible for the correctness of his/her entry, if when called upon to prove its correctness and the exhibitor fails to do so the entry may be cancelled or if already accepted disqualified.
- 4. Judges Interest: Competitors are requested to note the name of the Judge appointed in the particular classes in which they wish to enter and are advised in the interest of all concerned not to knowingly enter an animal where an actual or apparent conflict of interest may affect the judge's decision. Please see AHS 2022 rules.
- **5**. **Substitution of Judges**: The Committee reserve the right to change the identity of the judge for any classes from the one previously announced.
- **6. Age of Exhibits:** Horses/Ponies in ridden classes must be 4 years of age or over. Foals entering any ring must be a minimum of 30 days old on the day of the show.
- 7. Alteration of Classes: The Committee reserve the right to amalgamate or split any classes in the event of their being insufficient or over-subscribed entries.
- 8. Withholding Prizes: a judge may withhold any prize or prizes if, in his/her opinion, an exhibit is of insufficient merit. The Judges decisions are final.
- 9. Championships: It is a condition of entry that ALL first and second prizewinners will take part in the appropriate Championships, unless otherwise stated in the catalogue. It is the exhibitors responsibility to be present for final judging. Failing to present may result in disqualification and all awards and placings being null and void. Exhibits under veterinary certification will be excused. ECAHO Championships will be awarded as per the Standard ECAHO method (Blue Book 2022 p36)
- 10. Awards: The 9 GOLD Champions will receive red/gold garland and rosette; SILVER and BRONZE Champions will receive a silver/bronze rosette. Rosettes 1st-6th

- 11. Protests and Disputes: Any exhibitor wishing to lodge a protest against any other exhibitor must do so at The Show Secretary's Office within 30 minutes of the end of the class or the incident occurring. A written protest must be accompanied by the appropriate fee (£25). If a protest involves breaches of Arab Horse Society Rules and is submitted for action under those same rules then a fee of (£50) shall be required and the protest will be submitted to The Arab Horse Society under their Rules. Any fee submitted may be forfeited if the protest/Dispute is considered frivolous or vexatious. Any dispute as to the interpretation of the rules or any matters arising out of infringements or protests lodged by an exhibitor of The Classic Show shall be submitted to The Committee of the show for settlement whose decision shall be final and binding. Complaints concerning ECAHO classes will be dealt with under EAHSC Rules for Conduct of Shows.
- 12. **HEALTH and SAFETY:** The organisers of this show have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers and all the Officials and Stewards.
- 13. Exhibitors Risk and Responsibility: Neither the show venue owners, servants, nor the show Officers or Servants shall be in any way responsible or accountable for anything that may happen (from any cause or circumstance whatsoever) to exhibitors or their servants or agents or to any exhibit or to any vehicle carrying any exhibit or anything else brought onto the showground or for anything else arising out of the Classic Arabian Horse Show. EACH EXHIBITOR is solely responsible for any consequential or other loss/injury or damage done to or commissioned by or arising from any animal or article exhibited by him/her and shall indemnify the Show Organisers/Venue Owners against all legal or other proceedings in regard thereto. It is therefore the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure they have adequate insurance cover in place.
- 14. Medical/Veterinary/Farrier: Owners/Exhibitors shall be responsible for any/all costs/fees for services of these practitioners.
- 15. Passes: Spectators and vehicles will be admitted Free of Charge. No Horse box passes are required, but we request that all parking directions from either stewards, committee members or signs be obeyed.
- 16. Dogs: All dogs MUST be on a lead on the showground—Dogs are not permitted in the catering areas. If this may be a problem please leave your dogs at home. Thank you.
- 17. OUTSIDE ASSISTANCE. ECAHO: Blue Book 2022 p32: 23. a) Horses will appear in the collecting ring no less than 10 minutes before the start of the class. b) Exhibits that appear late (missing the walk around the ring) will be excluded from the class. c) Procedure in the Collecting ring No more than 2 persons are allowed to assist the handler in the collecting ring. These persons as well as the handler should wear the number of the horse, to identify them clearly. Anybody not wearing a number relevant to a horse in the respective class will not have access to the collecting ring. The show organizer must provide three sets of numbers per horse to all exhibitors. Only one person is permitted to assist the handler during the warm-up, using only a standard schooling whip with an attachment of plastic of max. 10 cm. All other support or aggravation from inside or outside the collecting ring is prohibited. Horses may be warmed up in the collecting ring, but to avoid injuries and overstressing the horses, they may only be lunged in big circles at a modest pace. Any chasing, hunting, or scaring of the horse is forbidden.
- AHS Rule 17 Attempting to influence the behaviour of exhibits in the ring is forbidden. Exhibits are not to be excessively stirred up. Horses must remain calmly in the collecting ring with a maximum of one handler/rider and one groom until they enter the ring. No devices, artificial gadgets or loud noises shall be used to excite horses. This rule also applies to persons on the outside of the ring or collecting ring. Exhibits which are excessively excited may be asked to leave the ring or collecting ring and be disqualified from their class
- 18. Anyone wishing to trade on the showground must obtain permission prior to the show.
- 19. Stables Competitors must notify the stable manager IMMEDIATELY if there is any problem/defect noted within the stable BEFORE stabling your horse. Any damage caused is the responsibility of the exhibitor (as named on the entry form) who will be charged for repairs. Photographs will be taken of stables prior to them being occupied. Our stable manage and the venue will inspect stables when they have been vacated.
- 20. Any horse deemed unruly in the stables or on the showground will be required to leave (no refunds).
